Field Technician - Laborer

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Assist in the site preparation and project operations

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the safekeeping and return of all tools assigned.
- Understand of the proper location for each tool in the work trailer or tool shed.
- Use Company tools and equipment in a manner to prevent damage to Company equipment or the property of others.
- Maintain clear understanding of the nomenclature of the tools, supplies and materials used in the site preparation for Terra's Projects.
- Maintain understanding of the specific uses intended for each tool and demonstrate an ability to use hand tools and small power tools.
- Upon arrival at the job site, unload the materials, parts, supplies and stage as needed.
- Breakdown all boxes/crates and load all trash in the trailers or trash receptacles.
- Assemble, erect and disassemble scaffolding, shoring and braces.
- Operate a chain saw and weed whipping devices for land clearing.
- Maintain understanding the concept of site grading and the proper preparation of the site for grading.
- Grade the site manually using a shovel and rake.
- Maintain basic understanding of rigging for unloading equipment and supplies
- Recognize the hand signals used for rigging and safety issues.
- Master the tying of several types of knots to include the following: Bowline, Half Hitch and Pressick
- Use a shovel and hand tools to work in trenches for the placement of PVC and other types of pipe.
- Operational familiarity with Godwin and Honda of pumps
- Set up and tend the various types of pumps, compressors, generators and be familiar with their maintenance.
- Apply the maintenance necessary for all the tools and equipment (oil & greasing) on the job site.
- Compact the soil using gas powered compacting devices.
- Position, align or level machines, equipment or structures.
- Install silt fencing and any type of temporary fencing.
- Ensure that the job sites are periodically cleaned and all debris is disposed of at the end of each day.
- Ensure that all tools stored in the tool shed are in their proper location at the end of the day
- Accurately use measuring devices such as a tape measure.
- Ensure that the site has been properly secured at the end of the day
- Support and comply with all components of Loss Preventions System (LPS)
- Regular and physical attendance is an essential function of this position
- Regular and reliable attendance is an essential function of this position
- These items are not meant to be exhaustive of responsibilities, duties or requirements. Additional tasks may be requested as needed to meet overall objectives of Terra.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS

- Good communication skills in written and verbal forms
- Good organizational skills, ability to prioritize and multi-task
- Able to perform job with little or no supervision or instructions

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be mentally and physically fit to perform assigned duties
- Must be able to stand, sit and walk for extended periods
- Ability to work in extreme temperatures
- Able to meet all requirements of OSHA Hazardous Materials Workers physical exam including pulmonary function test as defined by 29CFR1910.120
- Must successfully complete a Respirator certification physical examination
- Able to bend at the waist to reach within 6" of the ground
- Able to climb ladders and stairs without difficulty
- Must have manual dexterity sufficient for use of small hand tools, handling of small parts (e.g. nuts/bolts), and working with hands at various positions (e.g. overhead, front, low)
- No medical condition or impairment which would place the employee at increased risk in the event of an exposure to chemical agents
- Able to lift equipment weighing up to 100 lbs with another employee's assistance
- Must be able to work in extreme temperature conditions
- Good vision and hearing
- Drug free
- No physical condition which could jeopardize the health and safety of the employee or his/her co-workers
